School Meals

Please can we remind parents to order school meals for their child using the menus that are sent out on a Monday morning, with the deadline for return being 9 am on a Thursday morning. Mrs Edgar bases her food order for the following week on the choices that are made. An increasing number of parents are not ordering their child's meals in advance which is making it very difficult for Mrs Edgar to produce the correct amount of meals each day and to ensure the children who have ordered are given their first choice of meal. After the half term holiday the school is going to trial a new way of serving school meals. Children who have ordered will be served first to ensure they are given their chosen meal option and then children who have not ordered will be given their meals afterwards. Every child who wants a school

meal will have one but to ensure they get their first choice, please order the week before using the menu on ParentMail.

Athletics Competition

The competition at the Ellesmere Port Sports Village opened with an exciting hurdle relay race challenging reaction, speed, turning and baton changing, with both boys' and girls' teams giving their best.
