End of term church service

A reminder that the end of term church service will take place on **Wednesday 24th July at Aldford Church from 9am**.

Parents should drop their child off at church in the usual way. The service will last about an hour after which children should be returned to school for the rest of the school day. Children will finish term at the normal time of 3.25pm.

Naming of Uniform
